Criteria for naming

All names need to meet the following essential criteria:

- Cover the past and the future
- Not reflect a battle
- Be applicable to multiple generations
- Not include anything that can promote stigma
- Reflect South Australian people or places
- Be relevant to all veteran cohorts
- Shouldn't cause distress or be intimidating

The following criteria are desirable for names and may help to distinguish or choose one name over another:

- Not be too long
- Not replicating a name if it is already used in another capacity.

When names are chosen for all areas in the precinct, the overall collection of names will need to:

- Include representation of both genders.
- Include a name or names that are significant to Aboriginal or Torres-Strait Islander people.
